A Resolution Approving Use of School Facility Space by the Hobart Fire Department

Whereas, the School City of Hobart has partnered with the Hobart Fire Department and St. Mary Medical Center to provide opportunity for EMT training to students; and

Whereas, this program has proven to be a successful opportunity for vocational training and educational opportunity for students interested in the field of medicine; and

Whereas, the School City of Hobart has available space at Ridge View Elementary, and the Hobart Fire Department has expressed a desire to utilize several rooms for EMT instruction and simulations using equipment provided by St. Mary Medical Center; and

Whereas, the Board of School Trustees finds that the requested use will complement and enhance the training opportunities available to its students, and enhance the quality of emergency medical care available to local residents; and

Whereas, the Board of School Trustees desires to document the agreement to provide space for this use in writing;

Now Therefore, Be it Resolved by the Board of School Trustees of the School City of Hobart, that the Superintendent is authorized to enter into and execute an agreement with the City of Hobart for the use of space at Ridge View Elementary by the Hobart Fire Department for the purposes described above, and to set terms for said use, including insurance coverage, cleaning, and authorized access to the facility.

Be It Further Resolved, that this agreement shall be effective as of this date, and shall be for an initial term of one year.
