On Tuesday night, the Brickies boarded the bus and headed for Porter County to square off with the Kouts Fillies. Over the last 5 years, Hobart has won 3 in this matchup and Kouts has won 2 ... all competitive games ... and Tuesday night's contest was no different. The Bricks got on the board first with a pair of Ladan Weinman FTs, but ultimately Kouts held a 13-8 advantage after 8 minutes of play. In the 2nd quarter, Hobart BATTLED BACK - outscoring the host Fillies 12-6 in the stanza and taking a 20-19 lead into the halftime locker room!! The 2nd half was INTENSE as play went back-and-forth! Kouts retook the lead by 1 point heading into the final quarter of play and in spite of a GREAT EFFORT on the D-D-D-DEFENSIVE side of the floor by our girls, the hosts held on to win a close one 46-42. Senior Hallie Pendleton and junior Cali Bliss each scored 8 points to lead a balanced attack on offense for Hobart with Weinman, junior Riley Weber and sophomore Kurah Krucina all chipping in 6 points. Weber hauled in a team-high 7 rebounds and Bliss added 6. Weinman also dished out 4 assists while Pendleton & Krucina each finished with 5 steals in the loss.


