

On Tuesday night, the Lady Brickies hosted an NCC double-dual meet with Kankakee Valley and Lowell for the 1st conference competition of the year. The Lady Brickies SHINED in front of a great crowd and earned a split in the W-L column! Hobart lost to KV (113-72) but squeaked by the Red Devils 94-92!! Earning a 1st place finish was junior **Kacey Fleming** in the 1-meter dive! In fact, the Bricks swept the top 3 places in diving with senior **Alyssa Meinert** taking 2nd and freshman newcomer **Abigail Rinas** finishing 3rd! Senior **Brogan McDonald** (200 Free & 500 Free) and sophomore **Cassie Owens** (200 IM & 100 Back) each placed 2nd in two individual swimming events, and junior **Cassie Cohen** finished 2nd overall in the 100 Breast! Overall, it was a GREAT first competition in the water for our girls!!

On Wednesday night, the Brickies hosted both Rensselaer and future Northwest Crossroads
Conference member Illiana Christian for a tri-meet! In the first match of the night, our girls squared
off with the Illiana Christian Vikings. Back on November 9th, these two teams got together at the
Illiana Duals and Hobart WON by a score of 48-36. This time around, it was ALL BRICKIES!!! Starting
at the 145-lb class, the Bricks won the first two matches by forfeit, and then freshman **Bailey**Varella earned a PIN in just 34 seconds over her counterpart! Hobart won the next 5 matches in a
row including another PIN in just 12 SECONDS by junior Joanna Cantu! The Vikings were able to get
on the board, but ultimately Hobart WON the match 63-18 and our girls had 6 PINS in 36 seconds or
less!! AMAZING!!

In the second match of the night, Illiana defeated Rensselaer 36-35 in a barn-burner!

To wrap things up, our Bricks faced the Rensselaer Bombers in the final dual of the evening ...and once again, it was ALL BRICKIES!! Hobart won 11 of 14 weight classes and CRUISED to a 66-18 VICTORY!!

Seniors **Roxy Dominguez & Alicia Salamanca** ...along with sophomore **Ashley DeBusk** ...were the only 3 Brickies that had to wrestle twice ...and they all went 2-0 on the night!!

Well Brickie fans ... boys *wrasslin'* is back! Hobart had TWWWWW000000000 meets this past week and our boys SHINED in both!

Thursday night, the Bricks opened the 2024-2025 season on the road at Hammond Morton ... that's right, they were wrestling in the Governor's Mansion! Out of 8 matches wrestled, our boys won ALL 8 ...6 by fall ... and coasted to a DOMINANT 81-0 VICTORY!! Hobart also picked up 6 wins by forfeit to earn the shutout win!! Perhaps the most impressive "W" of the night was by senior **Cole Weber**, who pinned his opponent in just 46 seconds! WOW!!

On Saturday, the Hobart grapplers headed west on US 30 to St. John ... the destination was Lake Central High School for the Harvest Classic! This was just the second meet of the season for our boys and with area powerhouse programs like Portage and Lake Central competing ... along with the monster from Mishawaka (Penn High School) ... our boys were put to the test! After over a month of practice, the Brickies were hungry (... isn't that always the case for wrestlers?) and competed extremely well! Hobart put wrestlers on the podium in 9 out of 14 weight classes and had 3 individual CHAMPIONS!! Seniors **Daniel Mata (120)**, **Seth Aubin (126) & Aidan Costello (165)** all WON their divisions ... Mata doing so with a 1-0 THRILLER over his counterpart from Portage! Hobart also got a 2nd place finish from senior **Luke Juris (285)** and a 3rd from junior **Aiden Granger** (190)! Overall, the Brickies finished with 207.0 team points to place 2nd overall in the 16-team field! Portage won the overall title with a team total of 246.5 points.




















Basketball

On Tuesday, Hobart hosted Portage in non-conference action. It was a chance for the Lady Brickies to even up their record after THUMPING Calumet last week. The Indians were hot from 3-pt range early on and jumped out to a 12-4 lead after 1 quarter of play. Trailing 15-8 late in the second quarter, the Brickies rattled off 8 consecutive points to end the half!! The exclamation point of Hobart's run came when senior Hallie Pendleton BURIED a 3-pointer with less than 10 seconds remaining to put our girls ahead 16-15!! Throughout the second half, play was INTENSE and Hobart held a slim lead at 29-27 halfway through the 4th period when Portage went on a 9-1 run to move in front 36-30 with only 28 seconds remaining. Our Bricks NEVER GIVE UP!! Hobart scored on a putback by junior Riley Weber ... got a steal ... scored again on a layup by Pendleton and called timeout with 12 seconds left trailing by only two at 34-36!!! UNBELIEVABLE!!! A Brickie foul put Portage at the line, but the Indians missed both shots to give our girls one last chance!! Unfortunately, sophomore **Kurah Krucina**'s desperation heave from half court was on line but fell short as the buzzer sounded. It was a GREAT EFFORT from our girls in a very competitive contest against a Duneland Conference school.
