In the 2nd quarter, Hobart began to break down the Munster zone and find some scoring lanes ... playing even with the hosts and trailing only 17-10 at the break!! Unfortunately, our Brickie shooting went ice cold after the break, which enabled Munster to seize control on the scoreboard. Throughout the second half, our girls BATTLED HARD, but never could get going on offense and ultimately lost a tough one 51-18. Senior **Hallie Pendleton** scored 8 points to go along with her 5 rebounds ... junior **Riley Weber** tallied 6 points and also pulled down 5 rebounds for Hobart in the loss.

Saturday afternoon, the Calumet Warriors came to town for a non-conference matchup and the Bricks wasted no time in seizing control as our girls played some TENACIOUS D-D-D-DEFENSE and raced to a 20-2 first quarter lead! Hobart kept the pedal to the medal throughout the second stanza and held a 49-6 advantage at the break!! WOW! Over the final 16 minutes, the Brickies put the car on cruise control and won going away 74-20. Hobart got double-digit scoring from sophomore **Kurah Krucina** (14 points) and seniors **Ladan Weinman** (12 points) & **Audrey Wendel** (10 points)! The

Final score: Griffith 85, Hobart 61. **Basham** and senior **Felix Lopez** each scored a team-high 17 points and **Leonard** finished with his second double-double in as many games with 10 pts & 10 rebounds in the loss.

The Brickie cagers are an even 1-1 on the year and will be on the road again on Wednesday against the South Central Satellites. DON'T STOP NOW BOYS!!























BOOM - Turkey Leg for Kurah Krucina ...14 pts, 4 rbs, 3 assts vs Calumet




BOOM - Turkey Leg for Ladan Weinman ... 12 pts, 5 steals, 3 rbs vs Calumet

Wrestling


