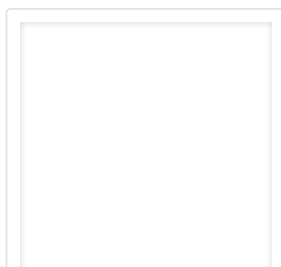
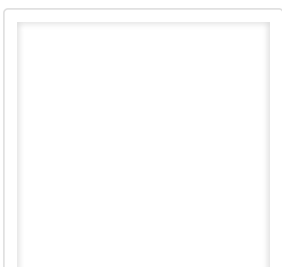
This year at Hobart High School we are focusing on what it means to have Brickie Pride.

Last month, in September our focus was Respect. Please join us in celebrating our students and staff who were recognized for having purpose!


