RE: Awarding of Dairy Proposals

Proposals for milk and dairy products were due on April 22, 2021. The Wabash Valley Education Center, the Northwest Educational Service Center, the East Central Education Center, and NIESC combined our dairy volume into one RFP. The consortium of member food service directors and ESC Team Leaders met on May 10, 2021 in Plymouth, May 11, 2021 via Zoom, and May 12, 2021 at East Central ESC to review pricing, proposal details, and to evaluate and score their vendor submissions.

Proposals were received from Dairy Farmers of America, DBA Schenkel Dairy, Clovercrest Dairy, Pleasant View Dairy, and Prairie Farms Dairy. Vendors were asked to supply a "firm" price and an "escalator/de-escalator" price with school owned coolers. The dairy proposal contract will run from July 1, 2021-June 30<sup>th</sup> 2022 with an option to renew.

DFA/ D.B.A. Schenkel's Dairy submitted a proposal on all districts in the consortium with the exception of the East Central Education Center Members. When contacted for clarification of this exception, they noted they do not include vendor supplied coolers in their proposal. East Central Members do not own their own dairy coolers.

Prairie Farms Dairy submitted a proposal on all districts in all regions. Prairie Farms noted multiple exceptions for delivery and districts were required to review these as part of their proposal. Prairie Farms sill offers pricing on vendor supplied coolers.

Clover Crest Dairy did not submit any proposals for the ECESC Members. They submitted a proposal on all participating districts from the NWIESC. The following districts from NIESC received proposals: East Porter, Knox, LaPorte Schools, MSD of New Durham, Nor th Judson-San-Pierre, Oregon Davis, South Central, St. John LaPorte, and Tri-Township. For WVEC, they submitted a proposal on North Newton and South Newton. For all districts with the exception of St. John LaPorte, they proposed a two-day a week delivery and did not offer vendor supplied coolers. St. John was given a one-day a week delivery option.

Pleasant View Dairy did not submit any proposals for the ECESC Members. They submitted a proposal on the following districts from NIESC and NWIESC: East Porter, Griffith, Hanover, Porter Township, River Forest, School City of Hobart, School City of Whiting, and Union Township. From the WVEC: North Newton and South Newton.

None of the participating vendors requested a fuel surcharge, offered a quick pay discount, or required a minimum order for d elivery.
