On Wednesday night, the Lady Bricks were on the road over at future NCC foe Illiana Christian. During first half action, play was COMPETITIVE as each squad tried to gain control of the contest. The host Vikings won the first quarter by 3 and our Brickies knotted things at 18-18 heading into the halftime locker room. Illiana pulled ahead by 4 during the 3rd quarter of play and were able to ultimately control the flow over the final 8 minutes to secure a hard fought 53-41 win over the Bricks. Hobart put 3 girls in double figures ... seniors Hallie Pendleton (13 pts) & Ladan Weinman (10 pts) and junior Riley Weber (11 pts). Weber also pulled down 7 rebounds while classmate Cali Bliss grabbed a team-high 8 rebounds in the loss.

Friday night, the wheels on the yellow bus went 'round & 'round to DeMotte for a HUGE Northwest Crossroads Conference game against Kankakee Valley. The host Kougars got on the board first, but Hobart responded with a floater by **Pendleton** to tie it up! By the end of the first quarter, KV held a 9-7 advantage. In the second stanza, the hosts built a 25-16 lead, but the Bricks were able to cut it to just 26-20 before halftime! Early in the 3rd quarter, KV AGAIN built a 9-pt lead (31-22), but our girls BATTLED BACK to tie it at 33-33 on a jumper by Weber that sank through the hoop just before the buzzer sounded!!! WHAT A GAME!! Throughout the final period, BOTH teams gave it EVERYTHING they had!! Unfortunately, Kankakee Valley was able to outscore the Bricks 18-13 over the final 8 minutes to earn the 51-46 win. It was a tough loss for our girls as they FOUGHT HARD as a team. Still, the Lady Bricks are showing improvement EVERY WEEK and are continuing to give a GREAT EFFORT each time out! The regular season is a journey and our girls are learning, growing and competing ... all things that will help them as the post-season rolls around.

Hobart is now 3-7 overall and 0-2 in NCC play. The Crown Point Bulldogs will invade The Friendly City on Monday for a non-conference showdown and arch rival Andrean will do the same on Saturday. KEEP WORK WORK WORKING LADIES!! WE BELIEVE IN YOU!!

The Brickie boys cagers started the 24-25 season with three straight road games (... which resulted in 2 W's & 1 L) and FINALLY got to play in front of the home fans on Tuesday night when the Calumet Warriors visited The Friendly City. This was the first road test for the Warriors after earning a split in their opening two games. Our boys looked GOOD early on our home court and raced out to a 14-9 lead after 1 stop! Over the next 16 minutes of play, the Bricks extended the cushion to 7 points and held a 36-29 advantage heading into the final period!! With 5 minutes remaining, Calumet buried consecutive 3-point shots to knot the scoreboard at 44-44, which made for an INTENSE finish. As the players ran up & down the court, play was FRANTIC ...and Calumet scored to take a 51-49 lead with just 27.3 ticks remaining. Hobart had a chance to tie or take the lead, but the Warriors forced a turnover ...made two FTs with 9 seconds left ...and left town with a 53-49 win. It was a tough finish for an otherwise very entertaining contest - one where both teams played HARD and had chances. Sophomore **Stephen Miller** scored a team-high 10 points and pulled down 7


10 rebounds in the loss.

On Saturday night, the Brickies were on the road at neighborhood rival River Forest. Junior **Jordan Johnson** got the party started by scoring the game's first 5 points on a layup and a 3-pointer! In fact, the Bricks would score 10 more points and lead 15-0 before the Ingots got on the board!! River responded to Hobart's 15-0 start with a 12-1 run of their own to close the gap to 16-12 after 1 quarter of play. Our boys extended the lead to 29-22 at the half, but River Forest battled back to cut the deficit to just 3 points ... 47-44 ... heading into the final 8 minutes. Play went back-and-forth with the Ingots taking a 59-58 lead with only a minute remaining. **Basham** was fouled shooting a 3-point-shot and made ALL 3 of his FTs to put Hobart in front 61-59. After a steal and another River Forest foul, **Gildon** calmly sank 2 more FTs to make it 63-59 and the Brickies would salt this one away from the charity stripe en route to an EXCITING 69-61 VICTORY!! **Basham** totaled 19 points & 4 rebounds ... **Gildon** also reached double figures with 10 points ... and **Lopez** added 9 points, 8 rebounds & 3 steals in the win!
