

#### **Boys**

























# **Swimming & Diving**














#### Basketball

Monday night, the Brickies hosted Crown Point in a game that was reschedules from early November due to the Bulldog volleyball team competing in the semi-state. The 'Dogs came out firing on all cylinders with a trapping zone defense that bottled up the Brickie offense throughout much of the first half. On the other end, our girls FOUGHT to keep the visitors out of the lane, but CP just dialed long distance and sank 3's to take a 32-7 lead into the halftime locker room. Hobart played much closer in the 2nd half, but ultimately the Bulldogs bite was just as scary as their bark and the went back the Hub City with a win. Led by senior Hallie Pendleton and junior Riley Weber, Hobart saw 10 different players get in the scoring column. Senior Ladan Weinman and sophomore Kurah Krucina each pulled down 5 rebounds in the loss.

On Saturday, Andrean visited The Friendly City for an NCC SHOWDOWN! The Bricks won the jump ball and **Weinman** BURIED a 3 on the first possession of the game! Unfortunately, this was the only lead our girls would possess. The experienced 59ers methodically worked the basketball for good shots against a TOUGH Brickie zone D-D--D-DEFENSE and slowly increased their lead each quarter. Hobart executed well on the offensive end and got some good looks, just couldn't convert enough to stay within reach. 
#### **Boys**


The Brickies are now 4-2 on the year and will head to Lafayette after Christmas for the Harrison Holiday Tournament!! GOOD LUCK GUYS!!







We'd like to give a SHOUT OUT to our Brickie bowling teams for some STELLAR achievements!






