

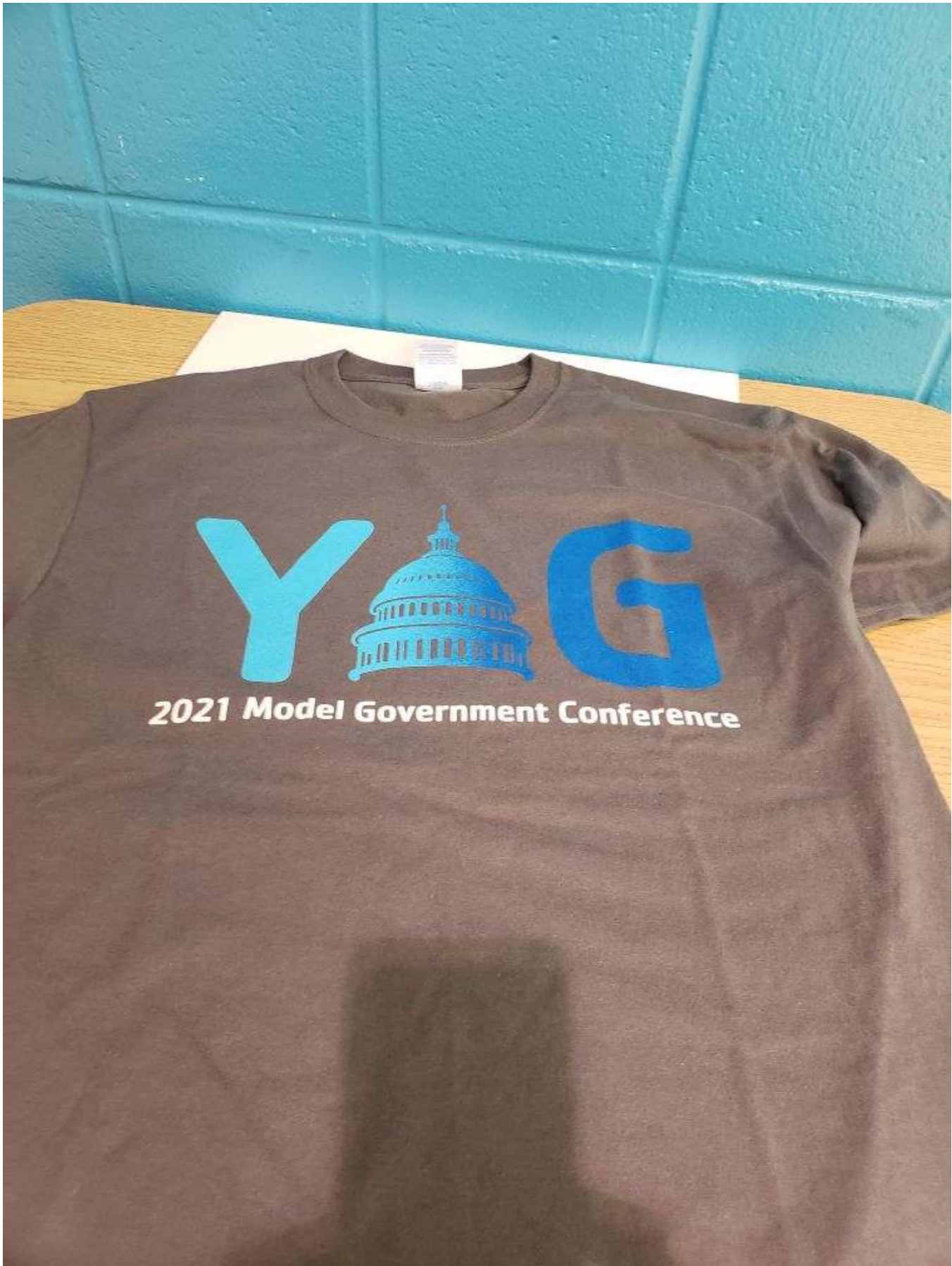
Youth ad Government Sine Virtually - #BrickiePride

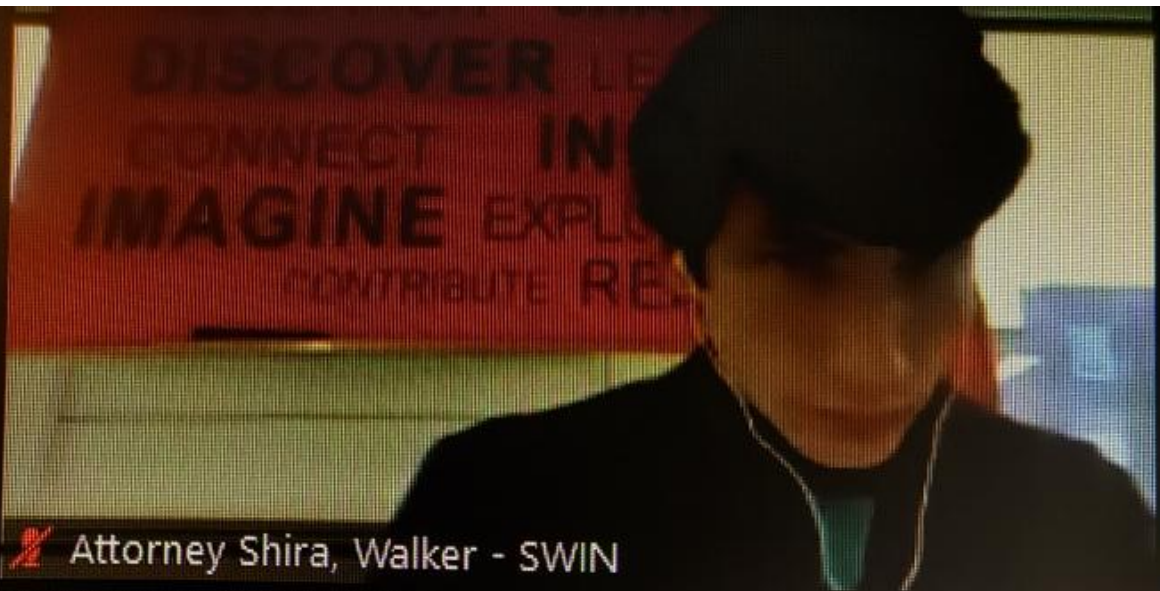
