In 1977, British rock band Queen recorded "**We Will Rock You**" for their album *News of the World*. In 2004, it was ranked as one of the top 500 songs of all time by Rolling Stone magazine. In 2009, it was inducted into the Grammy Hall of Fame. On Friday night, it should've been playing on "repeat" as the Brickies ROCKED the Cardinals 61-0!!

The last time these two teams met was September 7th, 2018, in the 1st year of Coach Osika's tenure as head coach of the Brickies. This year, East Chicago drew the bye in Sectional 17 and had an extra week of practice to prepare in hopes of pulling an upset. With a spot in the sectional championship at stake, to put it like Queen might've back in 1977 ... somebody had to put the Cards back in their place!

East Chicago's arrival at Don Howell Field foreshadowed how the evening would go for the Cards. Once the team was in the locker room, one of their buses got stuck in the mud and needed assistance from a tow truck to get moving again. Against the tough Brickie D-D-D-DEFENSE, the Cardinal offense also appeared as if it was stuck in the mud as Hobart registered it's 1st SHUTOUT of the 2021 season!!

The Hobart D was *SCARY* good a few days before Halloween ... junior **Noah Miller** led with 7 total tackles and classmate **Gavin Miller** was right behind him with 6 ... senior **Jake Simpson** had 4 tackles for loss ... senior **Alex Pickett** registered 1 of Hobart's 3 sacks ... sophomore **Bradley Gibson** recovered a FUMBLE, FUMBLAYA ... senior **Dakota Vanderburg** picked off his 3rd pass in the last two weeks and junior **Kris Velasquez** returned an interception for a TOUCHDOWN on the game's final play! INCREDIBLE!!

The only thing that might've been even more *FRIGHTENING* than the Brickie defense on Friday was the offense! For the 3rd consecutive week, our boys scored 20 or more points in the 1st twelve minutes of play!! Junior all-purpose back **Trey Gibson** scored all 4 1st quarter TDs for Hobart as the Bricks built a 28-0 lead. In the 2nd stanza, senior **Braydon Carlson** plowed his way into the endzone from 4 yards out and **Gibson** scored again to give the Brickies a 41-0 halftime cushion. With the rain continuing to keep fans under their umbrellas, senior **Luke Abbott** gave the hometown crowd reason to stand and cheer as he returned the opening kickoff of the 2nd half 76 yards for a TOUCHDOWN!! Queen said it best ... WE WILL ... WE WILL ... ROCK YOU!!





Freshman QB Noah Ehrlich was nearly perfect again as he completed 8/10 passes for 69 yards.

With their 5th consecutive victory ... a stretch where our boys have outscored opponents 270-66 ... the Brickies improved to 8-3 on the season and set the stage for a classic showdown of Region powers next Friday! Hobart will travel to The Inferno to face NCC rival Lowell in the SECTIONAL FINALS! This will be the 3rd consecutive year these teams have squared off with a sectional title at stake! Game time is 7 PM. DON'T STOP NOW BOYS!!
