RE: School meal prices for 2021-2022  
DATE: May 24, 2021

As a requirement of the National School Lunch Program School Food Service-Account Revenue Amendments related to the Healthy, Hunger-Free Kids Act of 2010, school food authorities are required to evaluate their paid lunch prices each year. However, the Families First Coronavirus Response Act (FFCRA) has allowed for the extension of Nationwide Waiver to Allow the Seamless Summer Option through School Year 2021-2022.

This waiver will eliminate the need to collect meal payments, including cash payments, at meal sites. This speeds up the service of meals, thereby reducing contact and potential exposure to COVID-19. It also facilitates recommendations for safe school meal service as recommended by the CDC.

I am recommending to the superintendent and the school board the following:

School City of Hobart will choose to operate under the Seamless Summer Option and accepts the flexibilities of this waiver and **not** charge students for meals (breakfast or lunch) during the school year 2021-2022.

Adult meal prices will remain at \$2.50 for breakfast and \$4.00 for lunch meals.  
Additional milk price will remain at \$0.50
